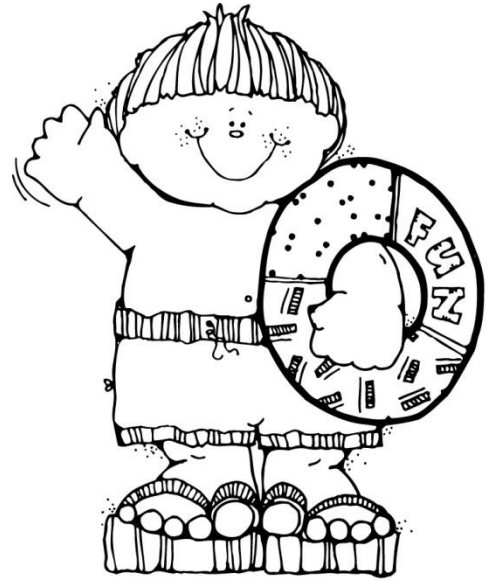

My name is Mrs. Wilcox and I am one of the 2nd grade Math and Science teachers. I am very excited about the next school year. Here are some things you can do this summer to gear up for 2nd grade!



♥ Count money! Have your parents give you a pile of change and practice counting it. Identify the coins and what they are each worth. When counting coins you always start with the highest value coin first and moved down.

♥ Use flash cards to practice your math facts. Begin with doubles (1 +1, 2+2, etc.) going up to 10 +10. Don't move on until you know them without thinking about it. 2nd graders should know addition facts with sums up to 18 and subtraction facts from 18 and should be able to give the answer in 2 seconds.



♥ Telling Time! Use an analog clock to tell time to the hour, half hour and quarter hour.
