## Admission Process 2019-2020

In order to apply for enrollment at Texas School of the Arts (TeSA), students must submit an application AND successfully complete the audition process. Students whose parent/guardian currently resides in any of the following TEA-approved ISDs are eligible to apply:

The entire process for secondary wait list application includes the following steps:

1. Applications must be received by November 1, 2019.
2. You are assigned an audition date and time when the primary wait list is exhausted and there are still openings.
3. Students prepare to audition by following the audition guidelines (requirements and rubrics) posted on our website: <https://mytesa.org/admission>.
4. Auditions are held on the TeSA campus. Parents/Guardians may bring their auditioning child on the scheduled date; however, parents may not accompany the child into the audition room.
5. Arrive to your audition 15 minutes early.
6. Resumes, academic standings, and letters of recommendation are not considered for admission; only audition scores are considered for admission.
7. Students will not receive a copy of the completed rubric or score.
8. In the case of illness, an audition may be rescheduled by contacting [admission@mytesa.org](mailto:admission@mytesa.org) prior to the original appointment. The school will assign a new audition date and time, which shall be within ten (10) days of the originally scheduled audition. A doctor's note must be submitted at the time of the new appointment.
9. Acceptance for admission is contingent upon successful completion of the student's current grade level.
